**MA Political Science 2021-2023 Admission**

**Circular**

For the Candidates included in the **Rank list (SureList & Waiting List)** who received memo for admission to the **M.A. Programme in Political Science (2021-2023)** are directed to report for admission in the Department of Political Science on **25<sup>th</sup> November 2021 at 10.00 a.m & 2.00 p.m respectively** with all the necessary certificates and documents in original. Admitted candidates who discontinue the Course after admission or whose e-Grantz claims are rejected, should remit Semester fees for the period of study. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and e-Grantz (eligible) applicants are required to pay Rs.340/- (Caution Deposit & Fee for ID Card).

List of documents to be produced at the time of admission is given below:

1. SSLC/CBSE/ICSE certificates or equivalent
2. Mark list of Plus Two or equivalent
3. Certificate and Mark Lists of Qualifying Examination
4. Caste/Community/Income/Non-Creamy Layer certificates (in case of those who claim reservation).
5. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
6. Equivalency certificate in case of candidates who completed their degree from a university other than University of Calicut.
7. Four Copies of Passport Size Photographs
8. Admission Memo and Online Application Form bearing a valid CAPID.
9. Two Copies of All qualifying certificates
10. A Community Certificate along with the Income & Assets Certificate ( Ref: GO.(Ms)No.128/2020/HEDN Dated 20.03.2020) issued by the Village Officer/ Thahasildar should be produced by the candidates who wish to avail of reservation under **EWS category** at the time of admission. Documents like ration card will not be accepted for availing reservation to this category.
11. The PWD candidates should produce a medical certificate issued by the district medical board or competent authorities stating that the disability is 40% or above. The category of the disabilities should be specified clearly in the medical certificate

*If the candidate fails to appear for the interview he/she will forfeit the claim for the admission.*
